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Why Eshkol Region?

Location

The Eshkol Regional Municipality is located in the Western Negev region of Israel and sits on the edge of the Negev desert. Eshkol is the largest agricultural region in country. With clear indication that the world is currently experiencing the process of desertification due to the lower accumulation of rainwater, this region of Israel becomes the ideal location for the study and research of Agriculture today.

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
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What we will offer
